- 2. Filling up of the Online Application Formis a pre-requisite for Admission and no application form will be entertained in offline mode. The candidates are required to fill the online application form as per the University Statutes/Guidelines. The University will not be responsible for any mistake/lapse on the part of the studentwhile filling up the Online Application Form.
- 3. CHECK LIST for applying online (Scanned copy of original documents to be uploaded):

 - ii. All Mark Sheets of qualifying examination
 - iii. All Achievement Category Certificates of qualifying examination

- 4. Once the Application Form is submitted Online, the system will generate online application fee link, wherein the Candidates are required to pay the requisite fee through Debit/Credit Card; Net Banking etc.).It is only on the payment of the requisite fee that the registration for the Admission will be completed.
- 5. The Online Application Processing Fee is Rs.250/- for all candidates before the last date. The candidate desirous to be considered under the Self Financing Seat has to pay an additional fee of Rs.350/- along with the application fee. The Online Application processing fee & Self Finance fee is non- refundable.
- 6. A candidate seeking admission under Reserved/Achievement Categories has to upload Self Attested copy of the Domicile Certificatealong with Reserved /Achievement Category Certificate's issued by the competent authority. No 'Under Process Certificate' shall be entertained under any circumstances for Admission under any Category.
- 7. A Candidate, seeking admission under any Achievement Category (i.e. Sports, Cultural & Literary Activities, NCC, NSS and Bharat Scouts and Guides) are required to upload a single PDF File, containing all the achievement certificates received during the period of qualifying examination(Last three years in case of M.A./M.Sc. courses and last two years in case of M.Ed. & Integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed.). Separate merit will be drawn after verifying the uploaded certificates by the concerned committee. No additional certificates shall be entertained after the last date in offline mode.
- 8. The Eligibility, Seats Matrix and Fee Structure of the Course/s is/are being appended in the guidelines.
- 9. The Admission of a Candidate supplying incorrect/factually wrong information in the Online Application Form will not be considered and is liable to be cancelled at any stage.

- 11. The Admission shall be made on the basis of the Common University Entrance Test (CUET (PG))score.
- 12. Appearance of a Candidate in CUET (PG) is mandatory for seeking Admission to the above programmes. Candidates who have not appeared in the CUET(PG) shall also be eligible to apply for the above-mentioned programmes. Such candidates will only be considered for the leftover seats and will be given second preference.

Participation in the aforesaid activities will fetch credits only if these are organized and/or authenticated by the concerned Wing/Authority of the University i.e. Office of the Dean Students Welfare. Certification to that effect by any other Organization, Body, Society, Club, University Teaching Department, College, Institution, NGO etc. shall not be entertained. Concerned Govt. Departments/Agencies organizing competitions in such activities and awarding participants therein, shall have to provide the list of prize winners/participants to the Office of the Dean Students Welfare of the University within a month from the date of completion of such a competition, failing which no credit shall accrue to a candidate seeking admission under Cultural and Literary Activities, though participated therein.

Note: No weightage for any intra-college activity certificate shall be given.

A. Determination of the Merit of a candidate applying for admission to 02 year PG Programmes of the Cluster University shall be as under:

- a) The candidates merit shall be considered as per their merit in CUET (PG) examination.
- **b)** The merit of candidates those who have not appeared in CUET (PG) applying for admission to PG Programmes of the Cluster University of Jammu shall be determined on the basis of marks secured in all the six semesters of undergraduate programme. Such candidates will only be considered for the leftover seats and will be given second preference.

c) Selection Criteria for Achievement Categories

Merit of the candidates applying under reserved categories of Sports/Cultural & Literary, and NCC/NSS/ Bharat Scouts and Guides activities as per University Statutes shall be determined on the basis of (i) marks/points awarded to such a candidate for these activities, plus (ii) one-fourth (1/4) of the merit of the CUET(PG) examination. The composite score thus calculated, shall form the basis of admission, provided that the candidate seeking admission unless covered under **Statute 16.3.11** has not been admitted to any programme of study in the University in an earlier session under the aforesaid reserved categories. Provided also, that where candidates have obtained equal composite score, the tie shall be resolved by reference to their achievement merit in the respective activity determined as per Statutes. Higher achievement merit shall determine priority in admission. Candidates who have not appeared in the CUET(PG) examination will be considered for leftover seats and will be given second preference.

- d) To be a beneficiary of reservation, the candidate must be a domicile of J&K UT, except when applying under categories (ii) i.e. Sports/Cultural & Literary activities and (iii) i.e. N.C.C./National Service Scheme/Bharat Scouts & Guides activities, for which he must have passed the qualifying examination from any recognized Board/University within the Jammu Province.
- e) Candidates who are not permanent residents of the territorial jurisdiction of the Cluster University of Jammu, but have passed the qualifying examination with not less than 60% Marks from a Board/University shall also be considered for admission subject to the condition that the number of seats under this category shall not exceed 10% of the total number of seats available in the programme of study.

ELIGIBILITY FOR 2 YEAR PGPROGRAMME

M.A. ENGLISH: For admission to the programme, first preference will be given to the candidates who have passed/appeared in BA (Honors) in English or with English Literature as the main, elective, or additional subject irrespective of whether the examination passed is in Arts, Science or Commerce stream for at least 4 Semesters. A candidate who has passed in the qualifying examination without English Literature subject shall also be considered subject to the availability of seats, if any, provided he/she has scored a minimum of 60% in the qualifying examination.

<u>M.A LINGUISTICS:</u> A candidate seeking admission to the programme must have passed/appeared in the final year of bachelor degree in any stream.

M.A. MUSIC (VOCAL & INSTRUMENTAL): A candidate seeking admission to the programme must have passed/appeared in final year of bachelor degree in the stream of Music. The candidate with Music as an elective/additional subject at Under Graduate Level or Honours in Music is also eligible. OR A candidate with bachelor degree in any discipline (Arts, Commerce, Science) from UGC recognised university with the following diploma course (6/7 years): SangeetVisharadPurna, SangeetPrabhakar from recognised following Music Boards of India: i) AkhilBhartiyaGandharvMahamandal, Miraj/Mumbai, Maharashtra. ii) PrayagSangeetSamiti, Allahabad, Uttar Pradesh.

M.Sc. FOOD SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY: A candidate seeking admission to the programme must have passed/appeared in the final year of bachelor degree examination with Food Science & Quality Control as an elective subject /B.Sc. Home Science as full stream/B.Sc. Medical stream.

M.Sc. GEOLOGY: A candidate seeking admission to the programme must have passed/appeared in the final year of B.Sc. Geology (Hons.)/B.Sc. examination with Geology as one of the core/elective subjects in all the three years.

M.Sc. PHYSICS: A candidate seeking admission to the programme must have passed/appeared in the B.Sc. Physics (Hons.)/B.Sc. examination with Physics as one of the core/elective subjects in all the three years.

M.Sc. CHEMISTRY: A candidate seeking admission to the programme must have passed/appeared in the B.Sc. Chemistry (Hons.)/B.Sc. examination with Chemistry as one of the core/elective subjects in all the three years.

M.Sc. BOTANY: A candidate seeking admission to the programme must have passed/appeared in the B.Sc. Botany (Hons.)/B.Sc. examination with Botany as one of the core/elective subjects in all the three years.

M.Sc. ZOOLOGY: A candidate seeking admission to the programme must have passed/appeared in the B.Sc. Zoology (Hons.)/B.Sc. examination with Zoology as one of the core/elective subjects in all the three years.

M.Sc./M.A. MATHEMATICS: A candidate seeking admission to the programme must have passed/appeared in the B.Sc. Mathematics (Hons.)/BA/B.Sc. examination with Mathematics as one of the core/elective subjects in all the three years.

M.A. HISTORY: A candidate seeking admission to the programme must have passed/appeared in the final year of B.A. History (Hons.)/ BA examination with History as one of the core/elective subjects in all the three years. All other candidates may also be considered subject to the availability of seats left vacant, if any, provided the candidate has secured a minimum of 60% in the qualifying examination.

M.Com.

- a) A candidate seeking admission to the programme must have passed/appeared in the final year of qualifying B.Com (Gen.) & B.Com (Hons.) under 10+2+3 pattern.
- b) 10% of the total number of seats will be available to the students who have passed/appeared in BA/BSc/BBA/BCA/ any other recognized Bachelor's Degree with not less than 60% Marks.

<u>M.Ed.</u>: A candidate seeking admission to M.Ed. programme must have passed B.Ed. with 50% marks.

<u>Integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed.</u>: A candidate seeking admission to 3 Year Integrated M.Ed. Course (B.Ed.+ M.Ed.) must have passed in the final year PG Examination of any recognized University with atleast 55% Marks.

M.A. EDUCATION: A candidate seeking admission to the programme must have passed/appeared in the final year of BA examination with Education as one of the core/elective subjects in all the three years.
